Pre-School and Morning/After-School Service.

We are delighted to announce that we will be opening a pre-school and Morning/After-School service on the school grounds starting this September when schools return. This is subject to approval from TUSLA. Both services will be located in the classroom that Mr. Gibbons currently teaches in. Mr. Gibbons' class next year will be located in the new classroom that is currently being built.

The pre-school will be run by Tina Clarke. This service will be provided for children of pre-school going age and will run form 9.30am - 12.30pm each day.

The Morning Club service will be run from 8.00am - 9.10am and the After-School service from 2.00pm - 5pm each school day. This service will be run by Elaine Rowley and is for the children of Kilrickle National School only.

Astro Surface

As part of the upgrade to the school play area we have been successfully granted permission to re-surface a large part of our grass area beside the tennis court using a 2G Astro Surface. This will cover approximately 900m² and will be located beside the tennis court. This work will be carried out over the summer months and we expect to have it in use for September.

Standardised Tests

The children in Mr. Kelly's and Mr. Gibbons' classes will be completing standardised tests in English and Maths on the week starting May 18th.
