Dear Parent(s),

New Classroom Build

As you are already aware we are due to begin our new classroom build shortly. **This building process will begin on Monday, March 22nd.** The new classroom will be constructed beside the main entrance to the school and our school shed will be knocked.

Access to the main entrance will not be permitted to pupils or parents for the duration of the building process. Instead all our pupils, including the pupils in the Infant room, will be asked to enter from our side door in the school. This will be demonstrated to pupils clearly before the commencement of building works. Parents can accompany the Infants to this school door as normal. Parents in the infant room can wait outside this door to collect their children after school at 2pm.

The school's builders will need access to the right of way between the school hall and the school building. Therefore it is not possible for any vehicle or person to access this area. For Health and Safety reasons **cars are not permitted to park in front of the hall during construction hours** as heavy machinery will be shuttling back and forth.

We therefore ask you to avoid parking on the grounds of the hall and park elsewhere, preferably at the community car park. We ask you also to be highly vigilant of such machinery when collecting and dropping your children to school each morning.

Parent Teacher Meetings


